**Indiana Farm Bureau AgELECT PAC Endorses  
Carolyn B. Jackson for Indiana House**

**(Indianapolis)** – April 25, 2018 – Indiana Farm Bureau AgELECT, the organization’s nonpartisan political action committee focused on state House and Senate races, has endorsed Carolyn B. Jackson in the primary race for Indiana’s House District 1. The district encompasses portions of Lake County.

“Carolyn B. Jackson is a first-time candidate who can help bridge the urban and rural gap,” said Katrina Hall, INFB director of public policy. “She is very interested in working with Farm Bureau to learn about agriculture in Indiana and we look forward to working with her.”
